Get started with the program

Details of the Just Project

Thermo Fisher will provide the instruments, kits and testing infrastructure to bring COVID-19 testing programs to all member schools, **at no cost to the institution**. This program will help ensure that students, faculty and staff at HBCUs can access testing so they can continue their important work during this pandemic.

The kits and instruments we are providing utilize the same emergency use authorization (EUA) workflow that is now widely used for COVID-19 testing.


The member universities will obtain samples on their campuses. Then samples will be collected and shipped to their assigned testing center.
