We have listed several key points about why coronavirus testing is important to keep kids learning in the classroom. - Variants may arise at any time the Omicron variant was a factor in the closure of over 20,000 schools across the country, due outbreaks in kids and staff
- Almost half of children with COVID-19 show no or mild symptoms, but are still infected and can spread the virus to others
- COVID-19-specific prevention measures to help minimize the spread of the virus, such as masks and social distancing, have been eliminated in many schools
- Less than 60% of all school-aged children in the U.S. are vaccinated against coronavirus, making them more vulnerable to the effects of the virus

To help reduce the impact of COVID-19 on the school community, we need an effective strategy to identify those who are infected early before symptoms develop and regular on-site COVID-19 testing could be the answer. As a concerned parent, I am urging you to invest in a COVID-19 testing program to stay ahead of an outbreak and help keep our children out of harm's way.

Luckily, testing in K-12 schools is supported by government funds, making it more affordable. Our state has received millions of dollars to use for school COVID-19 testing programs and I recommend exploring Open and Safe Schools.org to learn about the funding and how we can use it to support coronavirus testing in our school.
