The sample is registered and processed

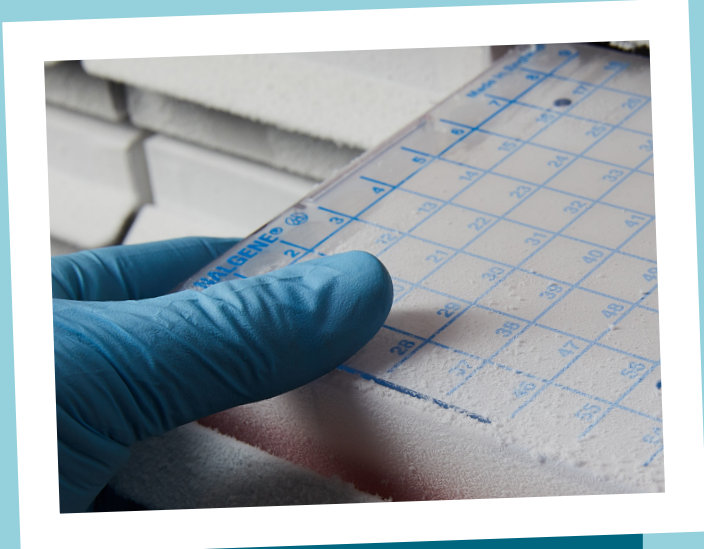


The sample is stored until it is requested
