Our pipette tip and rack mail-back recycling program provides you with a simple and effective solution for recycling.* Simply collect your used pipette tips and racks, and our convenient mail-back program will take care of the rest.

Follow these easy steps:

Collect

Use the original Thermo Fisher Scientific cardboard shipping box:

1. Line the box with the plastic bag (provided).
2. Collect pipette tips, tip racks, and plastic wrap and put in the shipping box. (**Note:** Must be free of liquids, biohazards, and any hazardous chemicals.)



5. Go to thermofisher.com/recycle-pipette-tips, enter your information, print out the waiver form, and generate a prepaid shipping label.
6. Place the waiver form in the box, close the box, and tape the bottom and top securely.

Ship

Ship your repacked box to us for free:

- Affix the shipping label to the outside of the box.
- Ship box via FedEx™ delivery service.

Pack

When the box is full:

3. Close the plastic bag and secure with the twist tie (provided).
4. Remove any prior shipping labels from the shipping box.

* Pipette tips and racks are recycled into building materials, e.g., recycled plastic lumber (not into new pipette tips).
