Description	The CD8a Mouse Anti-Human Monoclonal Antibody reacts with human CD8a, a cell surface receptor of 32–34 kDa. CD8a can exist as an α/β heterodimer with the CD8 beta chain, or as an α/α homodimer. CD8 binds MHC class I antigen, is involved in T-cell development, and activation of mature T cells. CD8a is expressed on most thymocytes and a subpopulation of mature T cells and NK cells.

Storage Buffer	The reagent is provided in aqueous buffer with 0.09% sodium azide, and may contain carrier protein/stabilizer.				
Storage	Store reagents in the dark at 2° to 8°C. Do not freeze. If the reagent is being diluted, it is recommended that only the quantity to be used within one week be diluted. Avoid prolonged light exposure with fluorochrome-conjugated antibodies. Use dim light during handling, incubation with cells, and prior to analysis.




Figure 1 Staining of normal human peripheral blood cells with CD8a Mouse Anti-Human PE Conjugate (Cat. no. A15827). Staining of normal human peripheral blood cells with CD8a Mouse Anti-Human PE Conjugate and a human CD4 FITC conjugate.
