Description	CD27 is a lymphocyte-specific member of the TNFR superfamily expressed by a subset of thymocytes and virtually all mature T cells. It is upregulated upon T-cell stimulation. CD27 binds to CD70, and through this interaction, plays an important role in T cell-B cell interaction.
