Invitrogen[™] *ccd*B Survival[™] 2 T1^R, DH5a[™], DH10B[™], OmniMAX[™] 2 T1^R, TOP10, and TOP10F' competent cells are derived from *E. coli* K12. K12-derived strains are unable to colonize and are therefore considered to be nonpathogenic in humans or other animals. BL21 cells are derived from a B strain of *E. coli* and are considered to be nonpathogenic. While the potential for colonization is slightly greater than that of K12 strains, they remain a Risk Group 1 agent and should be handled using Biosafety Level 1 conditions.
